



# CONSTRUCTING EXCELLENCE South West

## Role of the CESW Leadership Council

1. Identify the detail required to deliver the CESW Board's vision and offer support in determining that vision
2. Provide the regional hub for CE National Members, CESW clubs, CESW forums, LEPs, Industry Bodies, Universities and the entire supply chain
3. Identify and deliver priority actions within the South West of England to help achieve the joint industry and government ambitions between now and 2025. Only actions specifically aligned to our core principals should be addressed with other area identified passed to the relevant industry body e.g. training to CITB.
4. To live by the principles of Constructing Excellence
5. Act as a two way communication channel throughout the south west construction sector to ensure a united message and no duplication of resource and effort
6. Act as the South West's regional arm of the national Leadership Council/Strategic Forum whilst maintaining its governance through CESW

The industrial strategy for construction – [Construction 2025](#), was published in July 2013 and sets out a vision and 4 long-term ambitions for the industry:

- 33% reduction in both the initial cost of construction and the whole life cost of assets
- 50% reduction in the time from the outset to completion for new build and refurbished assets
- 50% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions in the built environment
- 50% reduction in the trade gap between total exports and total imports for construction products and materials
